Three Great Family Summer Destinations Involving IHMSA

As a 40-something year old with a family and a modest income, I understand the difficulty of balancing family obligations with my own personal pursuits. For all of us, there is always that critical balance of two of our most valuable personal resources—time & money. In looking at this year's IHMSA schedule and plotting out my family's summer plans, I see three tremendous opportunities in which a family could attend a top-notch shooting event which coincides with a great vacation destination.

Incidentally, these U.S. shoots rank as the 3 highest-attended shoots in IHMSA. In identifying requirements for a quality family vacation, each of these events:

- A. has affordable local offerings to make for a quality family vacation,
- B. can be done somewhat cheaply, with camping available on the range to help substantially save on room and board for those on a budget,
- C. is held during the typical "summer vacation" period in which kids aren't in school, and...
- D. feature world-class silhouette competition.

to do it on the cheap. It became a more than a 3000 mile round trip driving my wife's economy car from Colorado packed to the roof with guns, ammo, a cooler, and camping equipment, and I loved every minute of it. I stopped off at Idaho Falls to shoot at the Lava Bed on my way there, which conveniently last year had their state shoot held the weekend prior to the beginning of the WCC.

Arriving at Grants Pass kicked off about the most fun 5 days of shooting I have ever had. It seemed that most of the shooters camped at the range, either in tents or RVs. Every night, a different group was providing dinner for the entourage, as well as a great venison steak and egg breakfast one morning. Here I was an "outsider", but from the first minute I arrived, the camaraderie was like I was one of the group. Richard Slaton, a relatively new IHMSA shooter like myself, had traveled the furthest, coming all the way from Alabama to attend this shoot. Conditions were impeccable each day, as I shot a few personal bests, particularly in my standing events. I forget what Steve Ware said the average wind is there, but it is virtually nothing.

The silhouette range is located at the 300+ acre Josephine County Sportsman's Association, a county range that looks like a golf course. I told my daughter that it was the first gun range I have been to that has a kids' playground! There is an abundance of RV hookups, as well as shower facilities and spacious bathrooms with running water.

West Coast Championship Grants Pass, Oregon

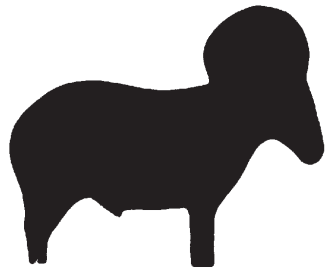
June 17-21, 2014

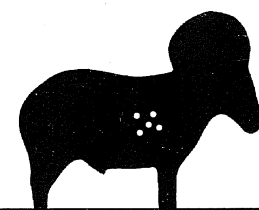

New IHMSA Practical Hunter Classes

IHMSA is proposing to add 3 new Practical hunter classes on a 2 year trail basis to start Jan. 1, 2011 and end Dec. 31, 2012. These are optional classes to be offered at the discretion of the local match directors. They not required to be offered at any State, Regional, or World Championship match. The purpose of adding these classes is to offer new shooters with hunting style handguns a place to compete with like style handguns in IHMSA.

New Class Names
Practical Hunter Long Course
Practical Hunter Short Course
Practical Hunter .22 LR Course

Class descriptions
All 3 classes are to be shot from any SAFE freestyle position including Prone, Kneeling, Sitting, or Standing.

The Practical Hunter Long Course will be shot on the 200 meter Big Bore range with the standard full size targets at their normal ranges.

The Practical Hunter Short Course will be shot on the 100 meter Field Pistol range with the standard targets at their normal ranges. The standard FP straight wall cartridges only.

The Practical Hunter .22LR Course will be shot on the 100 yard Small Bore range with the standard full size targets at their normal ranges.

Class Rules
Any hunting style handgun with a maximum overall length of 21 inches.
Optics are allowed up to a maximum of 6x power.
Gun must be as manufactured with only cosmetic modifications
Ported barrels are allowed as long as they are shot from a safe position.
A rest such as a bipod or a sandbag supporting the barrel in a prone position may be used by a new unclassified shooter and by shooters in classes A and AA.

The New Silhouette

Reminiscing

I meet a lot of die-hard single-discipline shooting fans as I attend various competitions and informal shooting opportunities. To be sure, there are some IHMSA shooters who focus on that one discipline. As you know, I enter a few rifle competitions and some of those folks are strictly long-gun minded, with some strictly centerfire-oriented while others stick to rimfire only, particularly 22LR. Even within gun-type-focused groups there are "specialists" such as shotgunners who only shoot trap or skeet, or sporting clays.

Specialties are fine, but for me, I prefer to take advantage of several shooting sports. Some would say that it is part of the reason I don't move along in capability as quickly as I otherwise would. Perhaps. Nevertheless, I am content with what I do and I don't beat myself on "off" days. If it came to that, I'd give up the pastime. After all, this should be fun.

We all have our own preferences and I respect other people's choices. One of the things I don't believe bodes well for the shooting sports in general is to put down someone else's preferred sport. I see some of this in every discipline I shoot. I've heard IHMSA shooters make derisive comments about those who punch holes in paper, while the paper punchers downgrade IHMSA targets as being overly huge compared with a tiny bullseye at any distance. The benchrest crowd pokes fun at otherwise quite acceptable groups by more casual shooters while the long range shooters (1000+ yards) downplay the benchresters.

Some participants in all the sports of the preceding paragraph wonder what's so hard about hitting anything with a scattergun, while the shotgunners may not see the big deal of placing a single projectile in a stationary target while taking plenty of time to aim. Within the shotgun crowd, there are also specialists who may only see the benefits of Trap or Skeet or Sporting Clays or some other game. We all make choices and should respect the choices of others. What's good for any segment of the shooting sports is good for all of us.

While I'm pretty spread out in pistol, rifle and shotgun sports, I certainly don't do everything. I'm not into black powder shooting or airguns. Nor do I have anything against them. I see each of these as being a whole new hobby and I have enough hobbies right now.

Setting aside my childhood rolled cap pistols and camp and gallery BB guns, my first experiences of having a primer igniting powder sending something down a barrel came from the arcade gallery sites that used 22 Shorts instead of BB guns. Chained to a table so as to make it impossible to shoot other than in a safe direction, these types of setups were common during my childhood and into my teens. Then, with permission of my parents and at first accompanied by my father, a group of us would head out to a gun store in the suburbs that had a shooting range in the basement. It had rental 22LR rifles or you could bring your own, which none of us had at first.

With what I could scrounge up from my meager teenage savings, I eventually bought my first personally owned gun, a Marlin Glenfield Model 101 which I have mentioned in previous articles. In addition to the pride of ownership, the savings over renting made shooting sufficiently more affordable so I could do it more often. Also, we found an outdoor range in another town to which you had to bring your own rifle. That range was prone only, but that's when I decided I definitely preferred outdoor shooting to indoor ranges. As long as we were safe and cleaned up after ourselves, we could shoot just about anything we wanted. Instead of traditional bullseye targets, I would stick a twig into the ground, sometimes with a small target tied to it and sometimes using just the twig itself for a target. Breaking a twig seemed more satisfying than punching a hole. While this was not the first time I shot reactive targets (that's what all the gallery targets were at the time), it certainly did reinforce my liking of them.

Right next to the abovementioned outdoor 22LR range was a trap range. My older brother, who now drove, had given it a try a couple of times with a very beat-

up pump shotgun he acquired that kicked like a mule, partly because I was unused to anything greater than a 22LR, partly because of the cracked buttstock that dug into your shoulder and partly because we didn't have niceties like shoulder pads or shooting vests. I really didn't like this very much, at least not until my Dad gave some tips as to proper hold and reacquired some of his shotgun battery from friends. These guns were in much better shape and at least some had rubber recoil pads. Dad had at least one of something in each of 12, 16 and 20 gauge in addition to my Mom's .410 Bore.

Once I reached 18 years old and was able to move from newspapers and supermarkets to factory work to earn tuition money, I met a friend in the factory whose family had some property in a more rural setting about an hour-plus drive from our city apartment. It was rural enough that we could set up our own 22LR plinking range and even throw-your-own trap. The travel costs were minimal back then and with the elimination of range and trapper fees, a lot more shooting could be done. In addition to my single shot Marlin, my Dad had a very cool Mossberg repeater which, although not very accurate, was a lot of fun to shoot. On the shotgun side, I tried everything he had, my favorite 12 gauge being goose-gun with a 36" barrel. While it looked ungainly, my hit rate was the best I could do with a 12 Gauge at the time and it didn't seem to recoil as much as the other 12 Gauge guns. The other gauges and the .410, while with lesser recoil, did not yield the same success as the goose gun. The .410 results were the poorest, but I loved to shoot it. I still have that Winchester Model 42 and in addition to its family-based sentimental value, the Model 42 has a rich history as a scaled down Model 12 and the shotgun for which the 3" .410 shotshell was developed.

Once out of school and with adult responsibilities and commitments, my shooting frequency diminished and for some periods there were huge gaps between events. It wasn't until many years later that I recalled how much fun I used to have at the range and reinstated regular, then frequent trips to various public ranges, eventually joining a club. The first public range was in the "new" location of that very same first indoor gun store I used to frequent as a kid. The old place had been destroyed by fire some years back. Perhaps it was fateful that my Company acquired a plant just a few miles from the range and our offices moved to the new location. While the store no longer rented guns to shoot, I had other ideas. This would be my first foray into handguns.

I started with a 38/357 revolver and a

9mm semi-auto, mostly because I followed the advice of a good friend of my brother-in-law, the friend having been a retired police officer. He knew a lot about guns in general, but with hindsight, I know that his suggestions on handguns were highly influenced by his professional LE background, perhaps different from what I would have started with if I knew then what I know today. That being said, they were good selections and the 38/357 combo chambering is my all time favorite, especially in my S&W Model 686. Since that time, my battery has evolved and become more purposeful, including more IHMSA-esque Models such as the T/C Contender and Encore.

Going to the indoor range after work, I soon had a following of regulars, mostly from the factory but some from the office as well. Unintentionally, it seems I had legitimized a closet pastime of several of our workers. Once I became aware of this effect, I made it well known that anyone who wished to try shooting was more than welcome to come to the range. It became a steady event. Besides being fun and convenient, I now had sufficient resources to expand my shooting horizons.

I still liked outdoor shooting better than indoors so I tried the local public outdoor range not more than 7 mile or so from my home. Creaking benches that gave way under the weight of my body, a muddy field with limited distances and a lack of what I considered adequate enforcement of safety measures pushed me to eventually look for a decent club to join. By this time, I was shooting rifles, handguns and shotguns at various locations.

Once comfortably situated at a club, I began to sign up for various events, including my discovery of IHMSA competitions. I also found CMP, rifle silhouetting and a couple of 22LR matches, as well as Sporting Clays. Falls Township Rifle and Pistol Association (FTRPA) has an excellent array of ranges and lots of activities. I had seriously looked at a few other clubs before deciding on FTRPA. It allows me to stay as diverse as I wish to do. At the same time, if a shooter wants to specialize and stay with one discipline, there are some truly world-class shooters at the Club that will give all the help and advice that a novice will accept.

My choice has been to stay diverse, but as I previously said, I don't do everything. Other shooters may stay within the confines of one or two items. Whatever the choice, I encourage anyone in the shooting sports to do what is comfortable, safe and fun. Any sport shooter, regardless of discipline employed, should be encouraged to keep at it.

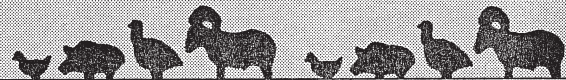

Some of the best shooting advice I have received came the first time I traveled to the Oklahoma State shoot three years ago. I was able to spend some time with IHMSA icon and world record holder Jim Fields, and besides getting several technique tips and learning the flop position from him, one thing he told me was that the biggest key for me at that point was to just get out and shoot more. I didn't have any Unlimited guns at the time, but that didn't matter. If I had a Production gun, I was advised to go ahead and shoot it again in Unlimited—probably won't win or place, but who cares? As long as you are shooting, you are getting better, and that is the whole point.

Two people that have certainly seen positive results using this approach are Russell Plakke from Colorado and Richard Slaton from Alabama. Russ has been shooting IHMSA for several years, and has become one of the top all-around shooters in Region 8. In 2013, he set a personal best by shooting 83 entries, and is set to shoot in his 3rd consecutive World Championship this summer at OKC. Russ doesn't show any signs of slowing down either; I wouldn't be surprised if he hit triple digits in entries in 2014.

Richard Slaton of Alabama also set a personal best in 2013, getting in a total of 41 entries (33 IHMSA, 8 NRA). This is an outstanding accomplishment considering that his closest SB range is 4 ? hours

away, and his closest BB range is now 7 hours. That is dedication to the sport! Richard made the trip to the West Coast Championship last June, and is planning to shoot in his first World Championship this July. Having shot with both of these individuals, I can tell you that they both are improving all the time and will keep coming on strong in 2014.

I've talked to many people over the winter who are working up loads for new toys. Seems like casting bullets is a frequent conversation that comes up a lot more lately. The .300 Whisper also seems to be a hot topic. If you get some good five shot groups at 100 yards/meters, send them in. I think all of us IHMSA shooters love to share load information and stories! If you want your targets back, I can certainly return them to you.

The silhouette season is now upon us, so I hope everybody out there has some weekends off to go shoot some steel. Send in some good targets, or if you had a great year of shooting IHMSA last year, tell us how many entries you were able to get in, and then try to beat that total this year. Until next time, be safe.

Guns may be bench rested over any solid rest as long as the gun is not in a Ransom Rest, vise, or any other mechanical clamping device. Lying on your back in a freestyle position and piling sandbags by your body for support is legal. This will allow scoped guns set up for creedmoor to better compete.

The Weaver Trophy:

Scoped centerfire handguns. Your best 5-shot group at 100 yards or meters. Guns may be bench rested over any solid rest as long as the gun is not in a Ransom Rest, vise, or any other mechanical clamping device. Lying on your back in freestyle position and piling sandbags by your body for support is legal. This will allow scoped guns set up for creedmoor to better compete.

The Merit Challenge:

Centerfire handguns with iron / open sights. Your best 5-shot group at 100 yards or meters. Groups must be fired from an IHMSA legal freestyle position. No benchrest or artificial support allowed.

The Daisy Avanti Trophy:

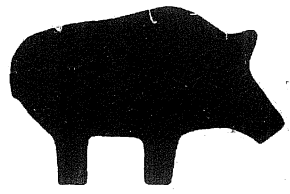
AIR Production guns with Iron/Open sights. Your best 5-shot group at 18 yards. Groups must be fired from an IHMSA legal freestyle position. No benchrest or artificial support allowed.

General Rules: All entries must be shot with IHMSA legal guns. Production, Revolver, and Unlimited guns are allowed in the Burris, Weaver, and Merit classes.

Witness: Winning groups must be witnessed by an IHMSA or NRA member.. Eligible winning targets must be signed and dated by the shooter and witness. Also, please include the shooter's IHMSA number and the witness's IHMSA or NRA number by their name. A witness is not required to enter but is required to win.

Targets: Targets submitted must contain no more and no less than 5 shots in each bull zone.

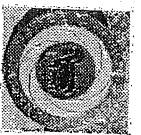

Match Publication Policy

As we continually have new match directors, following is the IHMSA News' policy on publication of state, regional, and "specialty" match notices and match results.

Any IHMSA sanctioned club in good standing may publish a notice of their club's state or regional championship match at no charge for three months. State match notices are limited to 2 1/4 "x5". Regional match notices are limited to 4 3/4"x5". If a club is holding a "specialty" match and that match does not replace one of these championships, the *IHMSA News* will publish a 2 1/4"x5" notice at no charge one time. These notices will run in Section B only. The club may publish additional notices of the same size for \$45 per issue. Ads must be prepaid before printing. All payments are to be sent to IHMSA HQ, P.O. Box 22356, Cheyenne, WY 82003. The club may specify whether the paid notice is published in Section A or B.

State match results can list both first and second place finishes. Regional match results can list first, second, and third place finishes. "Specialty" matches replacing a state championship may publish first and second place finishes. "Specialty" matches replacing a regional championship may publish first, second, and third place finishes. All other match results wherein the total number of handgun silhouette entries exceeds 11 (including all IHMSA, NRA & non-member guests) can list only the first place finish. Matches with less than 11 total handgun entries as defined above can list all IHMSA handgun entrants and their place. Regardless of the above, all 40's, 60's, and 80's (depending on the number of rounds fired at the match) can be published from ANY IHMSA match.

An IHMSA club holding a dual sanctioned (IHMSA/NRA) match may submit a match report for publication in the *IHMSA News* containing both IHMSA and NRA results. The number of published NRA results may not exceed the number of published IHMSA results. **Publication is limited to IHMSA sanctioned handgun disciplines only.**

Nearby Crater Lake is something I would like to spend a day at next time I am out there. But to be honest, I had such a great time doing nothing but shooting, talking shooting, and thinking about shooting, I essentially never left the range for the entire time I was there. The level of competition is just about on a par with what you will see at the Internationals, and I probably picked up more tips on shooting from this trip than any other I have experienced. A return trip is already planned, this time with the family, so we can fully absorb the many attractions this area of the country has to offer.

Region 8—Pringle, South Dakota

July 3-6, 2014

Located in the famed Black Hills of southwest South Dakota, this is my family's favorite shoot. As a new change to the schedule this year, the four-day Region 8 shoot has now been moved to the 4th of July holiday. Attendance at the Region 8 shoot has typically been in the 200-250 entry range, and I would expect that to rise even further with it now being in the heart of summer.

It's hard to imagine a better place to celebrate our nation's birthday, as well as just having a fantastic vacation. You can't beat the weather there in the summer, and the amount of things to do in this area is virtually endless. Mount Rushmore is a definite

must if you have not ever been there. For nature lovers, there are numerous caves, the large buffalo herd at Custer State Park, and the Badlands. History buffs might appreciate a trip up to Deadwood, which has gambling but isn't overrun with casinos—they do an admirable job of holding onto the true Wild West era. There is the 1880 steam train that travels from Keystone to Hill City, providing history lessons and scenery along the ride. Mining history is also abundant, for those who may want to tour a mine or try gold panning. Or if you prefer commercial attractions, Evan's Plunge is an affordable way to spend a good part of a day swimming with the kids in a warm natural spring, or Reptile Gardens in Rapid City is one of the most intriguing animal-themed attractions I have ever witnessed—we went there expecting to spend an hour, and ended up spending most of the day.

The silhouette range in Pringle is a treat within itself. This is a privately owned range, located on land that was homesteaded by the family over a century ago. With the automatic reset targets and 40 round matches, a person can get in a lot of entries in four days—my personal best is 21 entries. There is always a large contingency of campers and tents, with electric hookups, as well as water available. While permanent shower facilities are not available on site, there are always at least a couple of people with portable camp showers, including us, which by kindly asking, are always available to others. Otherwise, hotels can be found in nearby Custer or Hot Springs.

Just like at the WCC, nobody has ever went hungry at this shoot. Evening cook-outs fill the dinner hour on Friday and Saturday nights, with flatiron steaks being brought in by the Nebraskans and pot luck always providing a fantastic variety of culinary favorites. Neil always provides a sausage and egg breakfast on one of the mornings. Pretty much at this event,

if you aren't shooting, you're eating and socializing.

With this being an open shoot and in a great summer climate, this shoot always draws a large crowd. The last couple of years, IHMSA President Nancy LaCroix and husband Ken have made the trip, as well as fellow Minnesotans Steve Martens and John Richards, which definitely elevates the level of competition having these multiple time World Champions in attendance. Shooters from at least 6 states as well as Canada routinely attend this shoot, developing a welcoming sense of community over the years. This shoot also seems to have a larger number of children and teenagers in attendance than other events I have attended. Located off an isolated dirt road, the kids routinely group together and explore cowboy town, take people's dogs for walks, and make many trips throughout the day to pet the horses that are just across the fence. All of these factors combined with the fact that the owner/range officer is about the most personable individual you will ever meet make this an attractive option for anyone wanting to get out to the Rocky Mountain West.

World Championship —Oklahoma City, OK July 18-25, 2014

For any IHMSA shooter who has thought about attending a World Championship but just hasn't done it yet for whatever reason, I strongly encourage them to consider putting this on their "to do list".

Oklahoma City presents a fantastic opportunity to make it your first World Championship. It is about as centrally located in the U.S. as you can get. The range is absolutely fantastic, with auto-reset targets, an expansive firing line, and beautiful setting at the expansive OKC Gun Club. Camping is available on the range with water and electric hookups, an

RV dump station, and shower facilities in two different locations.

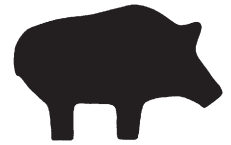
Hotels are a few miles away, located just off the interstate, and you don't have to drive through city traffic to get to the range. Yet, the city life isn't far away, and OKC has a surprising number of offerings of things to do in the city. A boat ride through "Bricktown", the downtown river walk, is highly recommended. Another favorite has to be child-friendly "Pops", located a couple of miles from the gun range in the small town of Arcadia. Pops is a soda-pop themed attraction on Route 66, with hundreds of types of soda pop available. The OKC National Memorial to the 1995 bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building is a most somber experience, particularly when viewing the Reflecting Pool and the Field of Empty Chairs honoring the 168 who died.

OKC hosted the World Championship for the first time in 2012, and the number of entries shot there almost doubled last year's total. IHMSA legend Jim Fields led the charge to get automatic resets installed in time for that Internationals. They have truly created a first-class silhouette range there. The one thing that may be a distraction for some shooters who have never shot there before is that the majority of the Oklahoma shooters use the Fields flop position, which requires the use of a muzzle break. If you are unaware of this position, I would encourage you to talk to Jim Fields (who developed the position and then went on to shatter the world record for consecutive shots made)—it is a great story.

But as for the muzzle breaks, there will be more of them than one may be accustomed to. However, since that 2012 event, they have since built portable wooden barriers that can be placed between yourself and a muzzle break shooter, thus substantially limiting the blast from a nearby shooter.

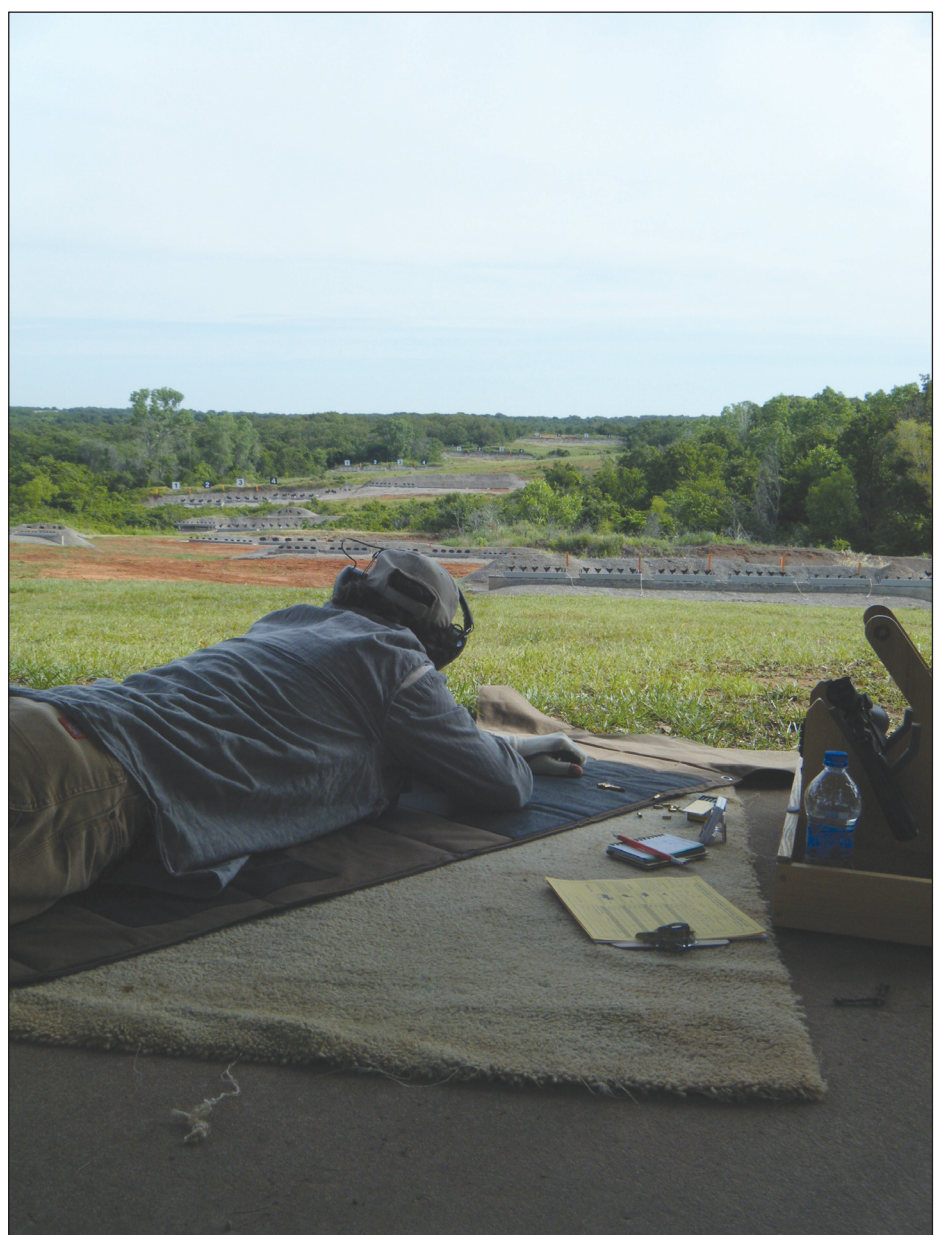
As for any shooters out there who have considered going to their first Internationals, here are a couple of thoughts from somebody who is only in his 7th year of competitive shooting, and has just gone to three Internationals. Prior to going to my first in 2011, there was certainly an intimidation factor having never attended one before—"God help me from doing something stupid!" and "I hope I don't get totally embarrassed by my inferior shooting!" were two thoughts that continually went through my mind. I soon found out while many of the top shooters in IHMSA are at the World Championship, there are also shooters of all abilities there. I also quickly learned that these most accomplished shooters also among the most outgoing people I have met in IHMSA. Spending multiple days at one shoot, learning and absorbing abundant information relative to competing in this sport, combined with the ability to focus on one's own shooting and improvement for several days in a row, is the most valuable experience I have encountered in this sport.

There are certainly other great destinations out there to incorporate shooting within your family itinerary. I hope to one day make it to the East Coast Championship, as well as having international travel added to my annual summer shooting schedule. For those with a family, the summer break from school certainly influences the planning of large vacations. If you are in that situation, I hope one of these three events may be within your grasp both financially and geographically, and can add a quality IHMSA experience to your family travels.
