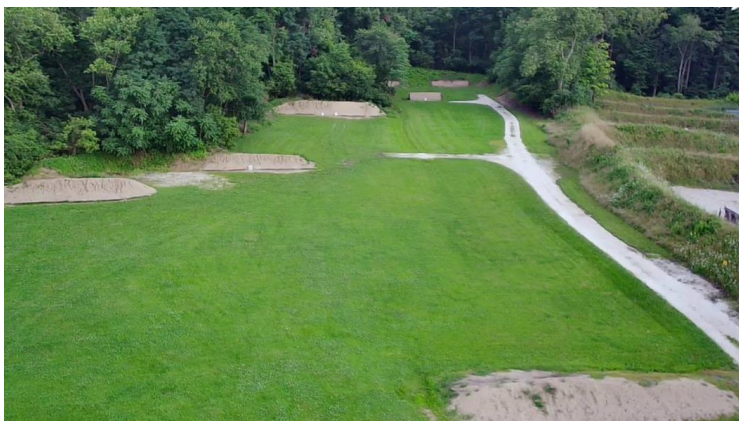

President’s Report

IHMSA Championships – A big thank you goes out to Rich Hawkins. IHMSA will have another championship match this year. Although this match is not the World Championships, it will be a great championship level match to plan on attending. Pour some powder and seat some bullets.

Rule Book – Approved revisions to the rule book have been completed. Copies are available upon request. It will be posted to IHMSA.org. Also, I plan to send some copies to match directors for distribution to members.

Bylaws – Approved revisions to the bylaws have been completed. These will not be posted publicly but will be available upon request and sent as a pdf or hard copy.

IRS Tax Status – IHMSA has not received a determination from the IRS as it pertains to refiling for non-profit tax status. When I get that information, I will share. Since Adams Brown in Kansas greatly assisted with a many year backlog of tax filings, they will complete the filing for 2021.

IHMSA’s Future – For 2022, some ranges across the country will not be IHMSA sanctioned. The tax debacle should be finalized. Riley Conservation Club will hold the IHMSA Championships. As I type this, IHMSA does not nearly have the renewed memberships as it did this time last year. The rule book and bylaws have been updated. Stephen Kuehl (2) and Raymond Golden (4) have taken on the directorship for their home regions. Thank you! Recently, I have received notices of deceased members. There will not be an 80-round World Championship event this year. In my opinion, 2022 is a mixed bag of positives and negatives.

For 2023, will more ranges discontinue IHMSA sanctioned matches? Will there be championship matches? Will anyone be willing to be Region 7 or 8 Director? Will anyone volunteer to be Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Director, IHMSA News Editor, Vice President, or President? My 3-year tenure expires in July 2023. I can’t speak for the other directors and officers, but I am done in July 2023.

What about 2026? IHMSA turns 50 years old! What will the 50th anniversary look like? I do not have answers for all of these questions, but sanction fees will probably still be \$2. I have been thinking recently about the future. In 1976, what was the 5, 10, 20-year plan for IHMSA? In 1996, what was the 5, 10, 20-year plan? In 2026, what will be the 5, 10, 20-year plan. I don’t know what the future holds, but it looks grim. With over \$100,000, should IHMSA spend money to make money? Should IHMSA consider a stipend for those who are working to keep it going? Should IHMSA explore purchasing and building a permanent range? Wait, I thought that already happened. Will IHMSA dissolve and donate the remaining wealth?

In the next year, IHMSA will need to fill many roles, transfer financial accounts to a new leadership, send office supplies, etc. It is not my intention to come across as a martyr. My life has changed for the better. Recently, I need to focus on and spend more time with April and Grace. Right now, IHMSA is taking time away from them, and I won’t let it continue beyond July 2023. In the meantime, I will continue to do my best for IHMSA in order to effectively transition to the next leadership.

Field Pistol Records Program 2021

I will be listing the high scores in the paper and am also going to post them to the forum for those of you who check it out. Dan Hagerty was kind enough to set up a records section when he redid the website. Thank-you Dan!

For those of you unfamiliar with the records program here are the guidelines as I understand them;

1. An iron sight score (P) of 32 or greater.
2. A scoped score (PAS) of 36 or greater.
3. An Aggregate; add both (combination of P and PAS) of 60 or greater.
4. You must be a current member of IHMSA to be included in the records.
(please include your IHMSA # when reporting)
5. The score(s) must be fired at a sanctioned match.
Please include name and date of match.
6. The two scores for aggregate must be fired at the same match.
(note; if the match is a multi- day match, i.e. two day weekend, multi day state, regional, etc. the two scores comprising the aggregate do not have to fired on the same day but must both be fired at the same match.
7. If the match is a 60 or 80 round Championship match the individual scores must be converted to 40 round equivalents to determine if they qualify for the records program.

Rule change forthcoming:

If the scores in a 60/80 round match are both odd numbers the total is added together before dividing for the aggregate score only. Here is an example. 80 round match P score 63 PAS score 67. The individuals convert to P-31, PAS-33. The agg converts to 65.

The Field pistol 60 club aggregate is the score I shoot for all year. I consider it the mainstay and most important but also most attainable of the records clubs.

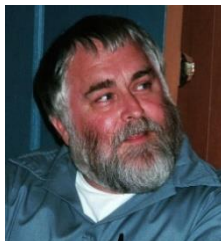
