IHMSA CAST BULLET COMPETITION - 2018

Key factors to accomplish with competition:

- Increased interest in IHMSA
- Recognize and facilitate a segment of our sport in a broader sense
- Promote sportsmanship and fair competition on a level playing field regardless of shooters current ability
- Increase knowledge level of cast bullet value for use in competition
- Be safe and have fun
- Match directors are not responsible for submitting cast bullet scores for this competition, the shooter will be responsible for doing so as described below.

General competition boundaries:

- To be eligible, competitive scores must be shot at a sanctioned IHMSA match between Mar 1 – Nov 31 of competition year by an IHMSA member in good standing.
- Bullets must be of a cast bullet design and have no jacketing with the exception of gas checks. No rim fire or air pellets allowed as a cast bullet
- All IHMSA rules apply to the competition as set forth within the current rule book or have been adopted by the board in recent decisions
- Keep it simple

Competition:

- Two competitive categories.
 - Category 1 - Scoped, includes the following:
 - * UAS/UASHS/PH/FPAS/US
 - Category 2 - Traditional, includes the following:
 - * U/UHS/P/R/S/FP
- Top four scores after addition of handicap shot by individual with cast bullets for the year will be aggregated for each category (Scope & Traditional) to determine that individual's final score.
- Scores will be sent to frstchckn@outlook.com by the shooter for tabulation along with category (i.e. UAS, PAS, etc...) and classification (AA, AAA, INT, etc...) no later than December 31, 2018.
- Scores can be from the same discipline or from different ones within the same category and will be adjusted to a 40 round match as needed.
- Handicap is based on shooters current classification in the category in which the shooter obtained the score. Handicapped scores will be rounded down to the first whole number. The following will be the handicap multipliers.
 - P/R/UHS/US/FPAS
 - * <AA = Score X 135%
 - * AAA = Score X 110%
 - * INT = Score X 100%
 - U/UAS/UASHS
 - * <AA = Score X 110%
 - * AAA = Score X 105%
 - * INT = Score X 100%
 - PH
 - * <AA = Score X 160%
 - * AAA = Score X 110%
 - * INT = Score X 100%
 - FP/S
 - * <AA = Score X 180%
 - * AAA = Score X 140%
 - * INT = Score X 115%
- Example: Shooter is a class AA in FPAS and shoots a 27. Shooter would be handicapped as follows: $27 \times 135\% = 36.45$: After rounding down a score of 36 will be awarded to the shooter.
- If a tie at the end of the competition exists, winner will be selected through a random drawing.
- Prize awarded will be one year membership to the Cast Bullet Association for each category (Scoped and Traditional).
- Write up of the top scoring shooters in the IHMSA news (may also submit to CBA) and will include load data as possible.

Ammunition

THE NEW SILHOUETTER

IHMSA silhouettes have a new friend in town in the form of the new Donkey Gong AR500 Steel Target from Birchwood Casey. It's a 1/2" thick 15.5" diameter steel target with a simple two leg stand that, when properly set, angles the target so bullets are deflected safely into the ground. (When setting the target, be sure to follow the instructions, making sure a properly safe angle is formed.)

Make no mistake; this is no light-weight. The shipping weight was over 32 pounds according to the paperwork. I didn't bother actually weighing it because I wouldn't want to face the possibility that my bathroom scale which cost less than \$20, could possibly be less accurate than my doctor's scale which I'm sure cost at least several hundreds of dollars. I always believe my home scale's lower reading. While my luggage scale measures weight pretty much the same as airline's scales at the check-in counters, I simply accepted the overall 30+ pounds after a simple calculation put the 1/2" steel gong at about a quarter pound shy of 28 pounds. Add a few pounds for the legs and shipping boxes and you're right on target.

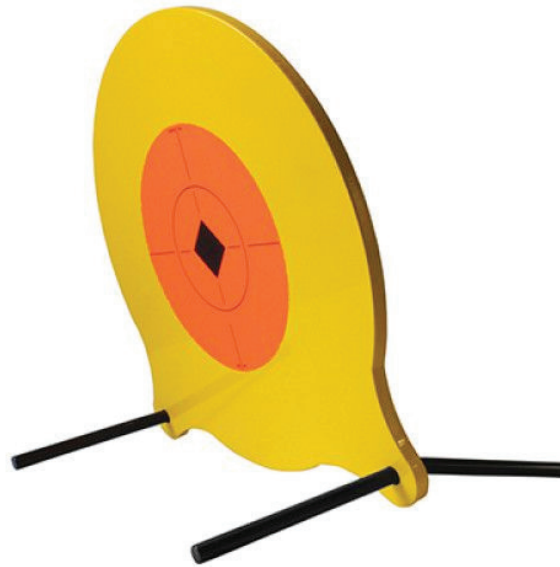
While reactive targets are a big draw of our sport, many shooters are limited to paper for sighting-in their guns and practice. Fortunately, Falls Township Rifle and Pistol Association does have swinging steel targets for use restricted to IHMSA members, but not all shooters have this luxury. The Donkey Gong solves that and it seems to fit everything we shoot except air pistols. According to the manufacturer: "The Mule Kick is rated for centerfire handguns and rifles up to and including magnum calibers. Handguns require a minimum distance of 25 yards. For rifles, the target should be no closer than 100 yards. High velocity rounds (3000+ fps muzzle velocity) or magnum calibers should only be used at ranges of 200 yards or more." Even though some of us use rifle cartridges for shooting, the lower velocities out of handguns should make our tamed cartridges safe. For IHMSA, everything I shoot will be okay with the Donkey Gong set at required distances of 25-100 yards for Small Bore and Field Pistol and 50 meters-200 yards for Big Bore. If you shoot some aberrant cartridge that attains rifle speed, do not use the target any closer than manufacturer warnings. Also, as with any target, make sure there is a safe backstop for misses, including ground strikes that may ricochet. Make sure no projectile leaves the range.

So what is AR500 steel? First, it has nothing to do with an AR firearm (that AR stands for Armalite Rifle), although you can certainly use an AR firearm with the Donkey Gong. In the case of the steel specification, the AR means Abrasion Resistant and the 500 indicates the Brinell Hardness. To put it in perspective, soft brass has a Brinell hardness in the neighborhood of about 60, depending on the alloy; mild steel is about 130 and many

stainless steels are about 200. While AR steel may be produced with various harnesses, 500 begins to push toward the maximum. Because of its impact resistance, common applications for AR500 steel include heavy equipment, armor plates, body armor and shooting targets. I've ruined enough steel gongs over the years to be able to tell what a waste it is to use materials of lesser quality with potent rounds. Since the Donkey Gong is good for Magnum rifle cartridges at 200 yards, I'm sure it will be good for anything I will throwing its way.

Unfortunately, my Donkey Gong arrived too close to the due date for this article to allow me to field test it. However, I wanted to get this out to you as soon as I could inasmuch as field testing will take a bit. Obviously, there are many things I want to shoot at this target but there are also some range rule issues at my club for which I have to get a waiver. I don't see this as a problem but it does have to go through its process. Falls Township and Rifle Association is very stringent on safety issues and anything that is not within the range rules requires a waiver. For example, I earlier had mentioned those steel swinging targets that are limited for use by IHMSA Members for practice.

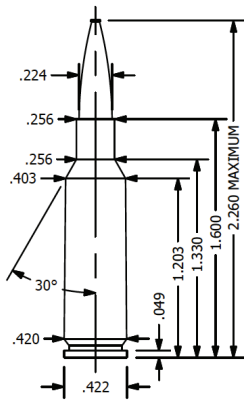
SIERRA RELEASES 224 VALKYRIE LOAD DATA

Remarks:

The 224 Valkyrie, developed by Federal Cartridge Co., is based upon the 6.8 SPC Remington case. The case length is shorter than the 223 Remington affording

the use of heavier match grade bullets with very long ogives and high ballistic coefficients (BC) in a semi-automatic firearm at magazine friendly overall lengths. This offers a distinct advantage over the 223 Remington, where the same bullets must be single-fed. Less recoil than many of the other favored competition cartridges is another notable benefit to the 224 Valkyrie.

Super-sonic velocities at ranges greater than the 223 Remington and the 6.5 Grendel can achieve at magazine length are also an advantage with the 224 Valkyrie.

As rifle competition venues get longer and faster, the 224 Valkyrie should certainly grab the attention of those who favor the AR platform, but the Valkyrie will perform very well out of all action types.

We had sort of a ceremonial 500 meter lifting of the targets immediately following the shoot-offs & the guest of honor operating what we call the magic twanger or wireless remote transmitter was none other than the wife of Barry Whitford, Janet Whitford who did the heavy lifting of all targets out to 500 meters, upon completing this task & with everyone giving her a standing ovation, where upon she planted a smack-er-roo on the side of my cheek & with husband Barry on my right elbow, I was a bit nervous!!

Some of the highlights of the match included April Edney & her husband Doug attending our match with April winning high lady in UAS-SB with a 79x80 & Doug winning several standing championships. Also thanks go to Zach Groves & Monica Malmgren for attending our match.

John Weaver won the scope category in ULTRA 500 with a 39x40, down a ram & Steve Martens winning both the ULTRA 500 iron-sight & the aggregate championship, 30x40 iron, 34x40 scope, which resulted in an aggregate score of 64x80, great shooting guys.

Jacob Weaver, John Weavers grandson, won several of the junior division categories, great shooting Jacob. I think he has an excellent firearms instructor.

Joe Cullison did it again winning the Iron man award with a 584x640, great shooting Joe.
