IHMSA Board of Directors Meeting
10 July 2023

Present: Doug Edney, President; Rich Hawkins, Vice President; Dell Taylor, Region VI; John Richards, Region V; Brian Gildea, Region III.

Called to order 8:15 AM

Warren Alkire recorded the notes even though he was not a Board member.

1. The Board members reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting.
 2. President's Report, Doug Edney
 - a. Mr. Edney shared that his work with a youth shooting organization reminded him of the need to emphasize muzzle control and safety at the event. He suggested that future events start with a safety briefing to remind the competitors of the importance of everyone being safe.
 - b. Mr. Edney thanked Rich Hawkins and the Riley Conservation Club for hosting the event. Mr. Edney especially noted Bob Hargis, Jim Kesser, Mark Basham, Cody and Alexis Hall-Stout and the target setters. Mr. Edney also thanked April Edney for cooking and being mom.
 - c. Mr. Edney announced he is willing to continue as president for another year especially to be able to finish up dealing with the issue with the IRS.
 3. Vice President's Report, Rich Hawkins
 - a. Financial report – organization is in good shape. Approximately \$150,000 in the bank.
 - b. Mr. Hawkins noted that Bob Hargis has worked tirelessly to prepare for and run the event.
 - c. Not from a VP perspective, but from an organization perspective, Mr. Hawkins put in a proposal to amend the rule that can be read as prohibiting practice before the event. The board seemed fine with allowing practice if there is no practice once the match started. Mr. Taylor read the current rule which states "no shooting once the range is closed for setup". Mr. Richards noted that had practice not been allowed for this match, the problems that surfaced during the practice would have delayed the first day of the match.
 - i. Rule: Section IX, 4, e.
 - ii. Original rule reads:
Once a range has been officially closed for preparation of a match, no practice will be allowed before or during any IHMSA sanctioned match other than the five-sighter shots as described above.
 - iii. Proposed wording to add to original wording:
- At championship matches and at the match directors discretion, practice may be allowed after the range has been set up on the day(s) preceding a championship match. There will be no practice time (other than 5 shot sighters) once the match has begun. The intention to allow this practice time must be announced as public information and/or in the match program at least 30 days prior to the match, and may be revoked if match setup is delayed.
- d. Recognizing the declining membership and the aging of most of our membership, the organization needs to have a serious discussion about an exit plan for the organization. A serious discussion is needed, but not on the Internet.
 - e. As a member of the Riley Conservation Club Board, Mr. Hawkins stated that the club would be happy to continue hosting the match. As an IHMSA board member, he believes the association would need to bump up the amount paid to Riley Conservation to \$2000 net paid to the club.
 - i. Mr. Taylor pointed out that offering a set amount for hosting the championship may encourage other clubs to step up to host the championship, which would be a good thing.
 - ii. Mr. Richards pointed out that IHMSA would need to have a specific set of deliverables for the amount (e.g., paint, target setters, etc.).
 - iii. Proposal: The IHMSA Board is offering \$2000 to Riley as host club for next year's match.
 1. Minimum of seven days
 2. Big Bore, Small bore, Field Pistol, air?
 3. IHMSA can offer stipends for line officers, gun registration, score entry, range setup separately.
 4. Still need to define parameters which may vary by club.
 - iv. Other clubs can also offer a proposal.
 - v. Need to make sure that the Board is covered by insurance for the match.
 - vi. It was decided to set up a meeting with the assembled competitors to present the proposal and see if other clubs would be interested in hosting next year.
 - f. Mr. Richards proposed that with the amount of money in the bank, the declining membership, and the likelihood of a limited life expectancy for the association, perhaps the championships should be offered with no entry fee.
 - i. A napkin sketch of the cost for a match is \$3500 which with the current bank

- balance would last over 40 years if other annual expenses were covered by the membership fees and sanction fees.
- ii. Shooters would need to have some buy in such as labor, so it is not totally free and allow for an equitable distribution of shooting spots.
 - iii. The waiving of championship fees would be mentioned as a benefit for the annual membership fee.
4. The secretary and treasurer positions remain open.
 5. Cindy Smith has fully paid her required legal restitution.
 6. An IHMSA membership has been revoked.
 7. Rules report, Dell Taylor
 - a. Australia would like to have rules amended to specifically mention IHMSA Australia for the Australian shooting organization. This would make it easier to have the Australian shooting organization release funds to IHMSA shooters to travel to the championship. Mr. Taylor stated it would be preferable to have wording that does not specifically mention Australia but covers all nations.
 - b. The Board asked Russell Mowles to submit a rule proposal.
 8. No reports from Brazil.
 9. No reports from Australia.
 10. Region 1, Allan Olsen, no report.
 11. Region 2, Steve Kuehl, no report.
 12. Region 3, Brian Gildea.
 - a. Has a new range since last championships, Cardinal Silhouette.
 - i. The club is part of a large corporation. Huge thanks to Bel fountain for helping get started.
 - ii. Mr. Gildea has agreed to host the ECC for 5 years.
 - iii. It was noted that berms need to be added.
 - iv. There were problems with the inaugural ECC match because of the lack of berms and losing a day because the range corporation had not reserved the range for that day.
 13. Region 4, Raymond Golden, no report.
 14. Region 5 John Richards
 - a. Picked up 5 or 6 new members that are proving to be really active.
 - b. A couple were picked up because of the air gun program.
 - c. The air gun program is producing more entries than powder guns.
 - d. Minnetonka Game and Fish are working on eliminating setup time and down time with air auto resets.
 - e. There are two clubs in Minnesota.
 - f. There is one club in Wisconsin, Marathon, paying sanction fees.
 - g. Oakdale gun club has started 1/5th scale.
 15. Region 6, Dell Taylor
 - a. Idaho Falls is a fairly active club. They throw in lever action rifle to keep things going. It is the only club in Idaho.
 - b. IHMSA lost Black Canyon.
 - c. Matches are still being run in Tombstone.
 - d. Las Vegas is running matches.
 - e. Hawaii is still running.
 - f. Utah has no range and no possibility of getting one because of the bureaucracy of dealing with BLM and the access to the 600 yard range.
 16. Region 7, Open
 17. Region 8, Open
 18. The membership director position is transitioning to Cathy Hillyer. This is a non-board position. Thanks to April Edney for her past work doing this.
 19. April Edney is willing to keep doing the *IHMSA News*. One print issue annually and the rest online because of the cost of printing and postage. There is a stipend for this.
 20. Sierra Sportsmanship award.
 - a. Mr. Hawkins nominated Bob Hargis.
 - b. Mr. Taylor nominated Paul Habig.
 - c. The vote was to award this to Bob Hargis.
 21. Mr. Edney is working on a proposal to help match directors by allowing them to hold matches purely on swingers.
 22. The meeting adjourned at 10:00 AM.

We were very pleased to once again host the IHMSA Championships here in Indiana. The match ran smoothly with some great target setters keeping us on schedule. The impact lights worked well again, and switching out full size for half scale targets during the match took only a few extra minutes. Attendance and entries were comparable to last year with 249 entries, and category champions hailed from seven of the nine states represented. Congratulations to Jared Richards who repeated as Iron Man Champion and added the Anschutz Unlimited Champion to several category wins. Equally impressive was the number of shooters showing their overall ability with aggregate scores for the Presidents 60, 100 and 140 clubs. How good? Imagine shooting a standing agg of 99x120 and coming in second! Big Bore had 5 shooters in the 100 club, one in the 140 club, and one with 60 Standing. Small bore had 3 in both the 100 club and 140 club, and 4 with 60+ in Standing. Field pistol had 4 shooters with 99+ hits, converting to well over the minimum 60 for Standing club. Congrats to Lynn Heckaman with his first perfect score in Air, and going on to hit all 10 shootoffs to win Air UAS. Junior shooters...all had attitudes, namely, they show no mercy on their elder competitors. If you want to beat them here, you better bring your "A" game cuz' they're bringing theirs!! Alexis Hall-Stout fired a 59 in SB UAS, Gabby Kuhs was right behind with 58, Cody Hall-Stout shot 56. Alexis and Cody went on to shoot impressive scores in UASFS, Gabby won PH22 with another 58 and fired a 39 in Air UAS. Sierra Sportsman Award went to Bob Hargis. Bob not only put in many hours preparing targets prior to the match, he worked setup day, called the line for five days, and fixed and maintained our targets throughout the week. Many thanks goes out to all the shooters in attendance. We sincerely appreciate your support and dedication, and hope to see everyone else at this event next year.

As we end one season and begin another, recaps are inevitable. The 2023 IHMSA Championship was again a success as the largest handgun silhouette match in the country. Riley Conservation Club was again the host facility and their 24 point firing line, ample staging areas, and air conditioned clubhouse was welcomed by competitors from 10 states.

The 2024 Championship will be at Anderson County Sportsman's Club in Lawrenceburg Kentucky. Kudos to that club for stepping up and hosting this event. I have shot there in the past, intend to shoot there in the spring, and hope to see you all there this summer.

Indiana 4H Shooting Sports entered the 21st century and has held two state championships. I get to serve as their "Silhouette Guy". Other states also offer Shooting Sports in their 4H programs. Getting IHMSA people involved is a chance for us to present our sport to a younger generation. In doing so, we can reflect on variations of our discipline, perhaps incorporating rifle or f-class type silhouette in our local matches and appeal to

a larger age group. Reach out, contact 4H and other young shooter teams or clubs, and arrange for them to experience a match at your facility.

My home club has been shooting indoor airgun silhouette for about 20 years. Individual knockdown targets are inexpensive, there are string reset racks available by a handful of sources, and DIY designs are available for those who want to go that route. It's a great way to keep in tone during the winter. Minnesota has the biggest airgun interest, I get sanction fee reports from them with what seems like a gazillion entries each year.

In IHMSA's heyday, we held chicken or pig shoots at the end of each season, often topping it with a BBQ at the club and a nice social gathering. Hope more clubs travel this route when the 2024 outdoor season winds down.

2023 IHMSA Members Meeting
11 July 2023

The meeting was called to order by President Doug Edney at 7:35 PM. This was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for members that have since passed.

The notes from last year's members' meeting were distributed prior to the meeting so those in attendance could review them.

1. President's Report, Doug Edney
 - a. As a result of working with a youth trap program which emphasized muzzle control, Mr. Edney said that it would have been good to start the match with a shooters' meeting to remind all of us of the importance of muzzle control.
 - b. Thank you to the members.
 - c. Thank for the Board members and the work they do behind the scenes.
 - d. Thank you to Riley Conservation Club for use of the facilities.
 - e. Thank you to Bob Hargis for the hard work and sweat during the match.
 - f. Thanks to those that were checking guns.
 - g. Thanks to April Edney for cooking lunch and dinner tonight, entering score and checking guns.
 - h. Though Mr. Edney was originally planning for this to be his last meeting as President, and as there are no other nominations, Mr. Edney announced he would continue in the position for another year. This is primarily to deal with the IRS situation as it would be harder to turn this over rather than finish it up.
2. The Sierra Sportsman's Award was awarded to Bob Hargis for all the many hours and hard work he has done for the

match. Mr. Hawkins was quoted as saying that “this match would not have happened without Bob”.

3. Secretary and Treasurer
 - a. These two positions are still open.
 - b. Mr. Hawkins has details on the position if someone is interested.
4. Financials Year to Date
 - a. \$138K to \$148K
 - b. Three accounts – PayPal, Checking Account and Savings Account.
 - c. \$6100 membership, \$4000 sanction fees
 - d. Spent \$5600 publishing the *IHMSA News*. The last issue cost \$4100
 - e. Around \$930 was spent last year for other expenses including office supplies, shipping, legal fees and billing for fees from Adams Brown that does the accounting.
 - f. Mr. Hawkins was asked, “With interest rates going up, are we getting interest from the Savings Account?” Jim Kesser asked about putting some of the savings account into CDs that are now running around 5% for a year.
 - i. After some discussion among the members, Mr. Kesser moved that approximately 2/3 in 150K that is fluid up to \$100K be put into a bank account earning around 5%. Mr. Urbank seconded.
 - ii. Greg Rheinheimer stated that the accounts should be FDIC insured.
 - iii. The motion passed unanimously.
 - g. Cindy Smith’s legally required restitution has been fully repaid to the Association.
 - h. Mr. Rheinheimer asked if any clubs were lost over the sanction fee increase. Mr. Hawkins said that some were lost. The question generally asked was what was gotten for the extra dollar. Mr. Hawkins stated that it was a poor decision historically that this fee was not raised several times over the years since the initial fee was established because the cost of things had steadily risen.
 - i. Dell Taylor reminded those present that the membership fee had been raised to \$50 but after the uproar, it was moved back to \$35 with the sanction fees as another way to raise revenue.
5. IRS
 - a. Mr. Edney gets letters around 2 times a month from the IRS. There seems to be communication issues with different parts of IRS.
 - b. After a letter, it is referred to Adams Brown who completes what is required. Then later a different letter arrives.
 - c. \$7700 in fees have been paid to Adams Brown so far to resolve this with the IRS.
6. Brazil and Australia have paid their affiliation fees but have sent no report.
7. Region I, Allan Olsen, not present, no report.

 - b. Picked up 5 or 6 new shooters with a couple coming from the air gun matches.

15. Rules
 - a. There has been a request by the Australians to have wording in the rule book mentioning the Australia shooting association to make it easier to request travel fund for the championship from the Australian shooting association.
 - b. No rule proposals have been submitted.
16. Membership Director
 - a. This position was established in recent bylaws changes.
 - b. April Edney has held this position.
 - c. Cathy Hillyer will assume this position.
 - d. Thank you to both of them for the work they do.
17. Mr. Kesser asked if there had been any discussion on redistricting to eliminate regions such as those with no clubs and better represent the current shooters population. This has not been considered. Mr. Kesser submitted as food for thought. Mr. Edney said the Board would consider it.
18. Old Business – no old business was brought forward.
19. New Business

- a. Mr. Edney stated that getting back to the IHMSA boom is not going to happen as the conditions are no longer present.
 - b. For the question of what you get for the \$35 membership fee:
 - i. A proposal has been put forth to award a stipend to a club to host the Championship. A meeting will be held at 9:00 AM, 12 July 2023 to discuss the proposal with any match directors present. Discussion will cover:
 - 1. What a club would offer for the stipend
 - 2. What a club would require from IHMSA
 - ii. Waving entry fees to the championship.
 - 1. The reality is that membership is aging and declining. There is a significant amount of money in the association's treasury. Waiving entry fees to the Championship would be a way to provide value to the membership.
 - 2. The question was asked, "What will IHMSA look like in the future and how long will the organization last?"
 - iii. Mr. Hawkins said that the purpose of the last 2 matches in Riley was to show how the championships could be held in a smaller facility with some creative solutions such as half scale for only part of the day.
 - 1. Mr. Hawkins would like to see the championships rotate around the country, so all areas feel a part of IHMSA.
 - c. The association should look at options and proposals to increase entries and reduce work on the match directors. Ideas include side matches, role of optics, swinger matches which would not count for record, etc.
20. As of the meeting there are 238 entries in the championships so far.
21. Mr. Edney and Mr. Hawkins did revoke a membership. This can be discussed with them after the meeting.
22. Mr. Hillyer raised some ideas of how to make the matches easier for physically challenged shooters. Others mentioned that help will be needed from the physically challenged shooters on ideas and what is needed well in advance of the match.

- 23. Dan Meserve moved adjourn. Mr. Brian (R3) seconded. Mr. Edney cancelled the motion to ensure all new business had been addressed.
- 24. Next year's match.
 - a. This is part of the discussion for the meeting tomorrow.
 - b. Nothing has been set yet.
 - c. Riley is willing, but this is part of the discussion for tomorrow's meeting.
- 25. Mr. Gildea moved for adjournment. The motion was seconded by Mike Dougherty. The meeting adjourned 8:38 PM.

Rule Change Proposal

Jan 29, 2023

Rule: Section IX, 4, e.

Original rule reads:

Once a range has been officially closed for preparation of a match, no practice will be allowed before or during any IHMSA sanctioned match other than the five-sighter shots as described above.

Proposed wording to add to original wording:

At championship matches and at the match directors discretion, practice may be allowed after the range has been set up on the day(s) preceding a championship match. There will be no practice time (other than 5 shot sighters) once the match has begun. The intention to allow this practice time must be announced as public information and/or in the match program at least 30 days prior to the match, and may be revoked if match setup is delayed.

My wife, Becky and I were able to take a vacation trip of a lifetime and made the best of our opportunity to visit both New Zealand and Australia. Our first stop was in New Zealand. We were there for one month and managed to take in both the north and south Islands. We then flew over to Australia and took in that country for just over one month as well. Prior to leaving the USA and making our way to visiting Australia, I had made contact via email with Russell Mowels who is the

Australian director for IHMSA, and I also searched the internet contacting shooting clubs that host Silhouette matches in Australia.

Years ago, I met Russell a couple of times when he came to our West Coast Championships competition in Grants Pass, Oregon. He and his wife traveled the USA and attended many IHMSA championship matches so I wanted to see about taking this chance on getting to shoot a match in Australia.



On this vacation trip I did not want to take my silhouette guns. I didn't want to deal with all of the customs and rules that are in place, possibly risk the chance of not being able to visit New Zealand and Australia, or worse yet having my prized toys held in customs or maybe being lost. Even though I chose not to pack my silhouette toys, being able to attend a silhouette match in a foreign country was going to be worth it to me whether I was a competitor or a spectator.



Many emails later and sorting out the details on where matches were being held, we found a place, and the dates were set. The match was to be held at the Monarto Shooting Complex on April 22nd through the

24th near Murray Bridge, SA where they were hosting an Ultra 500 meter and a special commemorative ANZAC Revolvers Only silhouette competition. Just a little bit of information to share is that Australia and New Zealand celebrate ANZAC day on April 25th every year. ANZAC meaning is: Australia and New Zealand Army Corps. ANZAC day for comparison is similar to our Veterans' Day. Russell managed to get me invited to the match and even offered to let me use one of his guns. Knowing that I was going to meet up with Russell, I put together some of my IHMSA Silhouette memorabilia from the USA that I have collected throughout the years and carefully packed them up to give to Russell to add to his Australia collection.

The Ultra 500 Meter pistol match started on Saturday April 22. We went out to the shooting range, where Becky and I helped set targets and meet up with everyone. Russell was scheduled to shoot the Ultra 500 on Sunday so all we did the rest of the day was help with re-setting and painting the hit marks for the next competitor in line.

We got up early on Sunday and headed back out to the shooting range and volunteered to help again with setting up the targets for the Ultra 500 Meter pistol match. Russell was set up for his entry using his XP-100 7BR with open sights. I helped Russell as his spotter and called out the shots for him. Open sights are way more challenging at the 500 meters than with a scoped handgun, and Russell just didn't

seem to have very good luck which I'm quite sure was due to the heavy oncoming headwind causing his shots to really go way off their intended target.

That evening everyone from the match gathered back at the Murray Bridge Hotel and enjoyed a great dinner. We all had a great time talking with new friends, telling tales and stories related to shooting Silhouettes, and comparing notes about the different ranges that we all have attended in past years.

On Monday it was my turn to shoot in the Revolvers Only match. Russell was first up using his Freedom Arms 357 mag and the game was on. I volunteered Becky to be his spotter because she always spots for me and knows her stuff way better than I do and how the shots go. Russell did pretty darn good and managed to set the bar for the rest of us competitors. I was fortunate to be able to use Russell's Freedom Arms 357 mag which is almost identical to my Freedom Arms 44 mag revolver. It was a standard 40 round match and after all of the scores were tallied at the end of the day, I won! I received a plaque for 1st place in revolver and a commemorative coffee cup. At the awards ceremony after the match, I asked if all of the other competitors and the target setters if they would autograph my score card. Now I have another piece of memorabilia to add to my collection of IHMSA Silhouette history pieces. Also at the match, Russell was very generous to me and presented me with his last available custom made Australian 40 Years Belt Buckle so basically I came out of this adventure like a bandit.

This was truly a once in a lifetime experience for me and my wife to have this opportunity for me to compete in a silhouette match outside of the USA. I felt honored and blessed to have represented IHMSA from the USA along with my passion for the game of silhouettes. And the "Icing on the Cake" is that I was able to bring back a bit of history and some memorabilia for my collection of IHMSA.
