# Competition will start at 11:00 every morning and end at 6:00 pm Friday through Tuesday 11:00 to 2:00 on Wednesday.

Targets are on tan sand backstops. Range faces a little east of south.

Big Bore relays will be scheduled from 11:00a to 3:45p.

Big Bore rams, 200 yards, will be hard set, hits must be confirmed.

1/2 scale will be scheduled from 4:00p to 6:00p with no 1/2 scale scheduled on Wednesday.

#### Wednesday big bore will be from 11:00a to 2:00p

If you are shooting multiple entries on the same day, please check all your guns in at the same time. We are going to try and reduce the number of hours the check in station is manned. Current plans are to be manned from 10:00 to 1:00. If you decide to add an entry or change a gun later in the day, get with an IHMSA officer or the match director to check in the gun.

Be prepared to shoot shootoffs immediately after shooting a perfect score. Last year, we shot all scoped guns immediately after the perfect score was shot. A notice will be posted at the match indicating which categories will be required to shoot immediate shootoffs.

Any ties that remain at the end of formal competition will be shot off after the final relay on Wednesday.

Winners and awards will be announced following the final tiebreakers.

Air gun competition has been tentatively scheduled for Sunday morning. Specific times to be announced later.

Last year we had so many air entries we shot over two evenings. If the demand is high, we will add an additional morning.

Please reference Rich Hawkins earlier post about range set up day on Thursday.

Practice and sighters will be allowed once the range is setup.

Once the range is closed on Thursday night, no further practice is allowed until the first sighter relay on Friday at 10:45.

If you are available to work on Thursday it will be greatly appreciated.

# LEGENDS OF SILHOUETTE #10: JOE KENNEDY

This may well be the last Legends of Silhouette article I write because this will be the last achievement that I know about that I consider worthy of this recognition. When I started doing this series, I knew of all the shooters I planned to write about (except, of course, the 40x40 in 500 meter iron sights which had not happened yet when I started), and it is now time for me to address the successes of Joe Kennedy.

This article includes a major surprise, something I did not know and has never been mentioned to me by any of the people I know. Read all the way, and be pleasantly surprised.

Joe started shooting handgun metallic silhouette in the early 1980s. He lives in Las Vegas, Nevada and works in entertainment industry. This means that he works most weekends, and he can not get to the range on match weekends to shoot more than a few guns. Since he is limited in how much he can shoot, early on he made the decision that since he was very good at standing, he would limit himself to only those disciplines

that are done in the standing position; big bore, small bore, field pistol/hunter's pistol, both iron sights and scoped.

Joe's first match was in 1980 at Redlands where he shot a Model 29 Smith & Wesson .44 magnum in the prone position.

My introduction to Joe was at the 1999 IHMSA/NRA Labor Day weekend match at the Los Angeles Silhouette Club. This was an NRA National Championship match. I was there, and I was very impressed when Joe shot 71x80 in Big Bore Iron Sights Standing. This is the record for Big Bore

Standing Iron Sights in an 80 round match. It is noteworthy that he missed three chickens on his way to the 71. This means he missed only 6 animals on the pigs, turkeys, and rams. This makes the 71 even more

impressive. In this performance he shot 15 rams in a row, I know of no one else who ever shot 15 rams in a row Standing Iron Sights. He also cleaned all 20 pigs and got 16 turkeys which is excellent shooting. In

that same match he shot 72x80 Big Bore Any Sight Standing. While this is not a record, the aggregate of these two, 143x160, is the aggregate record for both standing scores in an 80 round match.

Although Joe has been shooting scoped standing for the duration of the category, he never shot a 40x40 Unlimited Standing until December of 2021. This shows that his skills still are at their peak. He has all the various ten in a row iron sights standing pins so he is one of a very few silhouette shooters who has a grand slam in Iron Sights Standing. There are others who have achieved this level of success, but very few.

Joe shoots a TC Contender in 7TCU caliber. He shoots Sierra 150 gr. BTHPs over 23.5 gr. of H322. The position he uses is both hands on the rear grip with his arms fully extended. This has the advantage of

providing the shooter with the longest distance from eye to rear sight. Not a lot of shooters can hold steadily enough to make this work, but obviously Joe is one who can.

In 1990 at Raton, New Mexico he won Short Range Pistol and was National Champion. In 1992 he won NRA Long Range Conventional Standing. In 1998

he won Small Bore Pistol Standing and Small Bore Standing Aggregate. That same year he also won Conventional Standing Big Bore. In 1999 he

won Long Range Pistol Silhouette Standing and Standing Aggregate. In 2000 he won both Small Bore Standing and Small Bore Standing Aggregate

as well as Long Range Conventional Standing and Standing Aggregate. These were NRA scores, but I believe these are important achievements worthy of mention here. He has won a variety of State and Regional Championships, too.

Joe also holds the Chicken Standing Iron Sights Long Run Record at 40.

When I called him to discuss his 71x80, we talked for a while concerning the possibility of my writing about him. Then he said if I was going to write about him, he thought there was something else I should mention.

He said that in 1997 he shot 39x40 Big Bore Iron Sights Standing. That came as a major surprise to me, and I assume it will be a surprise to you, too. He said the Match Director never made any attempt to publicize this. He is not sure why this might have been, but since he is a very modest fellow, he never tried to spread this amazing bit of information.

If this had happened at a match I had put on, I would have tried to get the major networks to put it on the nightly news, but since then over the years no one has submitted this record to the various IHMSA records keepers. Consider this submitted now. When Joe sent me a bunch of information to use in writing this article, he included a photocopy of his 1997 IHMSA card, number 11029, showing 39x40 Standing at Desert Sportsmen range in Las Vegas on 11/16/97 signed "DW" as certification. Tell me that isn't a most excellent surprise.

I guess you want to know what he missed in the 39x40 Iron Sights Big Bore Standing. It was a chicken.

#### President's Report

Doug Edney

President's Message April 2023

By now, most of us have squeezed the trigger on a silhouette range. The bang and clang keep us coming back. Heck, even the bang and ... keep us coming back. That is the ultimate reason for continuing to shoot silhouettes. Many sports have evolved over the years including IHMSA. We could go on and on with the evolution of NASCAR, NFL, and even hunting. In PA, hunters can now use crossbows during archery. Kids can hunt as early as they want under the mentored youth program. I couldn't hunt until I was 12 years old. The Game Commission changed the opening day of deer rifle season from the Monday after Thanksgiving to the Saturday. Some people applauded these changes while others were upset. Those who were upset disliked the change in hunting traditions. For me, I just want the tradition of hunting to continue. Similarly, I want the tradition of handgun silhouettes to continue. It may be time for some changes. A wise veteran member told me recently how the current IHMSA has a shelf life. The expiration date is looming because MOAs, BFs, XP-100s, and other handguns aren't produced anymore. Additionally, the price of steel has increased dramatically even though it weighs the same. To assist with range setup, there are some accommodating features match directors could pursue. Magneto impact lights were used with success at the 46th Championships in Terre Haute, IN. Easier range setup is a must to combat match director burnout. With possible changes, I am concerned for the integrity of the game when

counting hits are considered and the traditionalist 3-4-8 gun members who still enjoy the roots of IHMSA.

In July 2022, we traveled to the 1st Adam Bender Memorial Shoot at Thunder Valley Precision in southeastern Ohio. The hunter match we shot was similar to PRS but for handguns. There were four targets per station with five stations including: tree stand, straw bale, box blade, fence post, and wood pile. Shooters engaged each target twice from closest to furthest (4 targets x 2 shots x 5 stations = 40 shot match). Every shooter had at least one spotter to confirm hits as the targets were swingers. I have confidence that every shooter who participated in this event had fun. It was different than some were used to, especially us IHMSA members. Recently, my brother made some fifth scale swingers for our match. He plans to make more targets of varied dimensions for a future trial of a hunter smallbore match. My plan for the four stations follows:

- 1. Four half scale targets (C, P, T, R) out to 100 yards for standing. Shoot closest to furthest. Three targets are painted black while one target is white. The match director (MD) chooses the odd colored target. For example, the pig is painted white. The competitor has 2 minutes for 5 shots. The competitor will engage the chicken first and once, pig twice, turkey once, ram once. For the 2nd string of fire in the relay, the shooter will work backwards by engaging the ram once, turkey once, pig twice, and chicken once. The competitor just fired 10 shots on 4 targets rather than 10 on 10 with free standers and target setters or 10 on 5 with hinged targets on steel banks and ropes to pull.
- 2. Four 3/8 scale targets (C, P, T, R) out to 100 yards for freestyle. The same as above applies to this station, but the MD could paint the ram an odd color.
- 3. Four 1/5 scale targets (C, P, T, R) out to 100 yards for the treestand, straw bale, fencepost, or wood pile. The same as above applies to this station, but the MD could paint the chicken an odd color.
- 4. Four 1/10 scale targets (C, P, T, R) out to 100 yards for benchrest. The same as above applies to this station, but the MD could paint the turkey an odd color.

Handguns are limited to a 15" barrel because it's IHMSA, not IRMSA. The competitor needs to have a spotter to call hits and score hits on the card. The competitor just fired a 40 shot match on 16 swinging targets. The pace of the string for the competitor increased because of moving scope elevation and parallax. The targets have gotten smaller for typical smallbore, but the positions have changed. The range layout and course of fire are up to the MD and could vary every match. This is not a rule proposal, just a trial of something new.

#### Vice President Report

Spring has arrived here in Indiana, although the north part of the state still has snow, and our April match here suffered 48 degree temps and 20mph winds. Nonetheless, I'm looking forward to another season of silhouette shooting! I'm sure many of us spent the winter months contemplating builds, tweaking loads, and changing sights or optics. Ammo and components are largely improved from a year ago with the exception of primers. Perhaps a bit more .22 shooting this year for some folks, or a bit of rationing on our fun time with centerfire guns.

Indiana 4H Shooting Sports entered the 21st century and will be having their 2nd state championship in May. Silhouette is part of their program. I get to serve as "the silhouette guy" and hope to steer some youth into joining us, with both handgun and rifle silhouette being offered.

IHMSA finances have improved this past year largely due to the completion of restitution from a previous court case. That, coupled with the increase in sanction fees, has us on pretty solid ground. You can review the financial reports elsewhere in this issue.

I applaud the MD's who add specialty events to their matches! In IHMSA's heyday, we held chicken or pig shoots at the end of each season, often topping it with a BBQ at the club and a nice social gathering. Hope more clubs travel this route when the outdoor season winds down.

As announced previously, we are very pleased to be hosting the 2023 IHMSA Championships at the Riley Conservation Club in west central Indiana. Match dates are July 7-12 for this 60 round event, and will include all events including PH Short course. In 2022, we experienced deep shadows that are not an issue in local matches, we are addressing that this year by swapping berms for FP and SB, with the 22's being in the center of the range and the FP targets along the woods, well suited for afternoon shooting. RCC is also adding 14 feet to the west end of the 100 yard berm, we'll be able to shoot targets in the sunlight earlier in the day, including fifth scale and the preliminary shootoff rack. Jim Kesser (jimologist@aol.com) is again doing the entry scheduling for this event. I continue to believe smaller clubs are capable of hosting championship events and can do it within the limits of their facility. I am hoping another club will pick up the IHMSA Championship for 2024. The ECC will be at the Cardinal Center in Ohio. This is a massive facility, I hope you will join us there in June.

A lengthy discussion is ongoing on the IHMSA forum regarding "starting IHMSA today". I hope you will read and engage in it. As we continue in the digital world, online discussion and news will gain ground as a means of bringing members together with timely input.

#### Rule Change Proposal Jan 29, 2023 Rule: Section IX, 4, e.

#### Original rule reads:

Once a range has been officially closed for preparation of a match, no practice will be allowed before or during any IHMSA sanctioned match other than the five-sighter shots as described above.

#### Proposed wording to add to original wording:

At championship matches and at the match directors discretion, practice may be allowed after the range has been set up on the day(s) preceding a championship match. There will be no practice time (other than 5 shot sighters) once the match has begun. The intention to allow this practice time must be announced as public information and/or in the match program at least 30 days prior to the match, and may be revoked if match setup is delayed.
