#### SANCTION FEE RULES REMINDER

Per SECTION IX: Match Procedures of the IHMSA Rule Book:

- 4. Delinquency in remitting sanction fees may affect the designation of 'good standing' of a match. The following policy applies to delinquent remittance of sanction fees:
- A) Matches more than 30 days delinquent (60 days after the date of the match) shall not be eligible to send delegates to the annual business meeting.
- B) After 90 days delinquency (120 days after the date of the match), the matter will be brought up for review of sanction revocation by the Executive Committee
- 5. Any organization hosting sanctioned matches that fails to adhere to IHMSA rules may have their sanction withdrawn by the Executive Committee. In the event of sanction being withdrawn, the affected organization shall, upon written request to the Secretary/ Treasurer, be able to have the decision reviewed by the Board of Directors.



#### MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

THE DIKECTOR

The message this month concerns two vital matters, the rapidly approaching International Championships scheduled for October 22-23-24 and the annual HMSA meetings that will be held in conjunction therewith. I urge all members and directors to read this message carefully so they will have a full understanding of the events to come.

Originally, the International Championships were conceived as an 80-shot match, with each competitor firing through the course (40-shots) in two different days with all winners then being decided on the aggregate total score of the 80-rounds.

This was originally predicated on the basis of an estimated 200 competitors. But as you all know, we are drawing more than 200 shooters from the Los Angeles and Boston areas for regular bi-monthly matches.

With the unprecedented interest and participation in this grand sport, plus its continuing rapid growth, it would be possible, with unlimited range facilities and at least five or more full sets of targets, that we could handle 500-700 shooters.

Further, we are quite cognizant of the desire and the right of every IHMSA member to compete in the International Championships. These simple facts, the right to compete, and the desire of a large number of IHMSA members to do so, have compelled us to change the 80-shot match concept to a 40-shot match, thus allowing twice as many members to compete.

## HMSA MARCHES ON

FLASH: READING, MASS., AUG. 14

"Catch us if you can," says Ron Ricci, Massachusetts State Director of IHMSA, in a last minute Special Delivery letter.

A new all-time record of 238 eager handgunners stalked the steel silhouettes at Camp Curtis Guild, hailing from as far away as Indiana, Pennsylvania, New Jersey and New York, All of New England was represented.

When the clang of toppling targets had ceased and the last whiff of smokeless powder had drifted away, John Towle of Albany,N.H. emerged as the Unlimited winner with a sizzling 30. (See above for a photo of John and his .358 XP-100).

Seventeen year-old Dale Small of Huntington, Mass., edged Rick Ambrose of Somersworth, N.H., by duplicating his score of 28, but with one more ram. Class A went to Dr. Martin Geher of Braintree, Maine, Class B to Ed Couture of Rochester, N.H., and Unclassified to Tom Roche of Hopedale, Maine.

For the upcoming Eastern Regionals, Ron advises that he has fifteen handguns in the value of \$3500.00 for first, second and third in every class including Unclassified. (Look out for another attendance record!).

#### EDITORIAL

A long, sincere, intelligent letter from Karel A. Smith Jr. of Stockton, Califor-nia, is the basis of the editorial this month.

The major point of Karel's letter was covered in the first issue of THE SILHOUETTE, but as Karel is a fairly new member of IHMSA along with 600-700 more, neither Karel or the others got the first issue. Therefore, this being a rather important matter, and somewhat misunderstood, we felt it proper to cover the subject again at this time.

Karel, in his letter, mentions attending the Fallon, Nevada match on July 31, and highly compliments Tom Lammel and members of the Stillwater Firearms Association for their fine job of putting on and running the match. He then disci

sand running the match. He then discusses Unlimited guns, and we will pick up his comments in mid-paragraph:
.....I surely agree with the statement that the Unlimited gun has produced fascinating handgun development we wouldn't have otherwise seen. I have been most intrigued by looking at, and in four care the relief with the statement of the second a few cases handling some of the extreme creations that have come out of this— those are just dandy guns, and their inventors are bringing that much more interest to handgunning as a sport. I'm looking forward to being able to get myself one of those super-Buck-Rogers creations and see just what it can do.

However, (and here is where Karel "However, (and here is where Karel begins to make his point) I am somewhat at a loss to understand one of the rules that appears to be current in the game; that relating to recoil reducing slots disqualifying an otherwise "production" gun, and would like to offer a little comment. There is something to be said for not forcing a competitor to buy a new the product of the comment. gun just in order to compete reasonably. In my case, I've been shooting (at something with something) for a lot of years, and when I discovered the recoil reducing slots, proceeded to do all my centerfires that will take it. So, the most appropriate gun I have for silhouettes is an S&W M57 long barrel—which was ported long before I heard of silhouette shooting. That foot melkes ported long before I heard of silhouette shooting. That fact makes me compete with the 15" sight radius super quality single shot guns in the Unlimited class. This seems to me unrealistic. The comparison of accuracy potential between a fine both-action XP-100 with long barrel and other refinements, and that of ANY revolver, is rather extreme. Understand that I'm only a neophyte at this, and have been in no denorge whetever of and have been in no danger whatever of not winning because of my gun—so far! But had I shot a really terrific score, I'd have had to beat 33 in that last match which probably isn't that common a Here, we interrupt Karel's letter to comment as well as answer his point.

Karel's point is well taken! The man

with an ordinary production revolver with recoil reducing slots cut in the barrel, and who is forced to shoot against rrel, and who is forced to snoot again... ...a fine bolt action XP-100 with long barrel and other refinements,...." in the unlimited class surely doesn't stand a

We agree completely! And as the rules now stand, any revolver so equipped does have to shoot in the Unlimited category. Karel has hit on exactly the right word,

"refinements," and we will be using it many times throughout this editorial. Okay, the whole matter seems rather

the whole matter seems rather and cut-and-dried at this point, doesn't it? It surely is unjust and unfair to force a man with a production revolver to compete on equal terms against what Karel calls a "super-Buck-Rogers creation" just because the revolver has recoil reducing slots or holes cut in the

But Karel, there is much more to the subject than the point you have made and which we have agreed with.

Now, let's discuss the subject more thoroughly and bring in other points made by other shooters regarding the

One argument goes like this: "After all, the recoil reducing slots don't make the gun shoot more accurately." That being the case, then we have to

ask this simple question: Why have the slots cut in the first place?

In any event, to use Karel's word, this is a "refinement" to the gun, and not a cheap one. It entails packing the gun, paying postage and insurance (you'd better have it as many guns have been lost in the mails) shipping it, paying whatever the fee is-and we've noted that the cost runs from \$30 to over \$50

that the cost runs from \$30 to over \$50 depending on who cuts the slots or drills the holes — and waiting the two weeks to six months to get it back.

What, then, does this "refinement" do?
Well, it is supposed to reduce the recoil by reducing the upward thrust of the muzzle, and therefore cuts down on the heavy recoil punishment. It saves the heavy recoil punishment. It saves the wrist, elbow and arm from tiring, allows a smoother string of shots to be fired; allows the shooter to get back on target faster for another shot and, well, you've all read the brochures and testimonials from the various firms that offer recoil reducing services. (And it is about time for the Editor to insert a personal time for the Editor to insert a personal to present any minutesters.) time for the Editor to insert a personal remark to prevent any misunderstanding. We have absolutely nothing against any of the recoil reducing techniques, slots, holes, weights or whatever. We have several firearms so equipped including an Auto Mag which came equipped with a slotted barrel, and we've had to buy an unslotted barrel to shoot the gruin in the production elses.) the gun in the production class)

To continue: Shooting one of the big magnums through the silhouette course, at least 40-shots, possibly 80, is sort of a day's work, especially if said shooter is using home-brewed "dynamite" loads in

While on the line as Range officer, I've seen shooters quit part way through a match with their hands split and bleeding, especially in the web of the hand between the thumb and forefinger from the outlandish recoil. On those occasions the shooters have NOT quit, most have become so recoil "happy" that they are flinching like crazy, especially when they get to the last bank of targets which usually is the rams, and when they have usually is the rams, and when they have to use their "super-dynamite" loads—or think they have to—and at a time when—at 200 meters—they must have the most steady, solid and flinch-free shot they can get off.

And so, Karel, we come to it: If half of the propaganda claims by the recoil educing firms are true—and I presume they are, then doesn't the man with the recoil reducing slots "refinement" have a distinct edge or advantage over the man with a production gun with no such refinements? In fact, as one shooter put it recently, if he had to shoot his genuine production gun against other shooters with the recoil reducing "refinement" he would feel they had an unfair advantage

would feel they had an unfair advantage and that he was, in fact, being cheated. And then, of course, comes the flood of valid arguments by all other shooters. If we allow the recoil reducing refinement to satisfy this man and that man, then why can't I have a trigger shoe on my gun? Why can't I have micro sights on my revolver? Why can't I have an XYZ rib put on my gun? Why can't I have a crowned barrel on my gun? Why can't I have a heavy barrel for my gun? Why can't I have a heavy barrel for my gun? Why can't I have a heavy barrel for my gun? Why can't I make a custom wrist-support grip for my gun? Why can't I have a super-speed cylinder turner put on my revolver? Why can't I put a jackass, double-whammy bushing on my gun? And each of them will add, "After all, you let Tom, Dick and Harry have recoil reducing slots put on their guns!!!!" And so it would go, ad infintum until we have a 50-page rule book listing the 148 "refinements" that are allowed on

"production" guns. And they all cost money, plus the time, plus sending your gun to this specially firm or that master gunsmith and then to three or four more. According to a friend who knows about such things, they made exactly this mistake on one of the 45 ACP pistol games. To be "in" you have to spend about \$1000 for a gun with all the "refinements" and that, of course, puts Mr. Average shooter "out" of the game. Mr. Average shooter "out" of the game. Let's don't let this happen to the IHMSA production gun category!

Now, Karel, having discussed the above, let me briefly mention a probable solution to the "refined" production gun problem—and we are fully aware there are a lot of "refined" handguns around.

Lee Jurras, Our New Mexico State Lee Jurras, Our New Mexico State Director, and a most informed handgunner, is quite aware of the entire problem as discussed herein. Lee has come up with a proposal to be discussed and voted on at the annual meeting just seven weeks from now

In brief, Lee's proposal is to create a third category of competition within IHMSA to be called Modified Production.

(I herewith quote from Lee's proposal)
"Opens up a whole new ballpark to
literally thousands of existing handguns that have custom grips, trigger shoes, sight inserts, mag-na-porting, ribs, bull barrels, and Behlert MMC, S&W, Bo-Mar, Micro, Elliason sight combinations. One or more of these modifications really shouldn't put the owner shooter

in the Unlimited category..."

We would welcome letters to the Editor regarding Lee's proposal, and said comments will be put before the national

meeting.

We close this editorial with one final point as regards Karel Smith's thought-

Let's say, Karel, just as a matter of academic discussion, that a ruling was passed allowing you to use your gun in the production class with the recoil reducing slots. Would you mind, as a competitor in the same production class, if the next man taped a two-pound slug of lead under the barrel of his gun? In all fairness, considering that you were allowed the recoil reducing slots, how could you object? Yet he would have a considerable and unfair advantage as regards the reduction of recoil and muzzle jump, and even greater advantage depending on the shooting style or technique he could use as a result of the lead weight.

The whole point of this editorial is that The whole point of this editorial is that IHMSA is not "against" any or all of the herein mentioned refinements, as such, but that we are "for" the simple proposition of protection for all our production gun shooters so they can compete with each other on equal terms with stock poduction guns and enjoy the sport without being forced to all the time trouble and exponse of humin terms. trouble and expense of buying \$500 to \$1000 worth of "refinements" in order to compete with a few other production gun owners who can afford the cost.

How about it, IHMSA production gun owners, do you agree with this basic philosophy or not? It's time to take a pulse reading. pulse reading. Send us your comments, pro or con.

#### **NEW GUNS** AND BARRELS

In the first issue of THE SILHOU-ETTE, we reported the results of a trip to the NSGA show in Chicago on February 4-5-6 by Executive Director John Adams and Elgin Gates.

We reported looking at Dan Wesson's

1977 offerings which included new .357 interchangeable barrels for all their target models in 8-10-12 and 15-inch lengths. In that same issue, our Eastern Executive Director, Bob Zwirz, reported working with one of the Dan Wesson 15" barrels. Bob also reported in the June issue additional details on the Dan Wesson barrels as to rear sights, vent ribs, plain barrels, bull barrels and other improvements. Although official word has not been received as yet as to the current status of said barrels, we call attention to IHMSA's ruling elsewhere in this issue that production must have started by August 15, and 200 units must be in the hands of retail dealers by ope in the hands of retail dealers by October 10 to be eligible for the International Championships on October 22-23-24. We await word on this from Dan Wesson or our Eastern Executive Direct-or Bob Zwirz.

At the Chicago show we also saw prototypes of various new barrels in the Thompson Center booth to be added to their ever increasing selection of accessor barrels.

We have received a brochure and letter from National Sales Manager Bob Gus-tafson advising that interchangeable 10-inch bull barrels in ten calibers 10-inch Dull barrels in ten calibers including the new 41 magnum have been released to the public and that production has started on their series of 14-inch straight bull barrels with receiver style rear sights, magnum style grip and special forend. We are advised that the initial run will be 500 units in several heavy calibers, and will be in the hands of dealers in ample time to meet the October 10 deadline.

Other than the 8-10-12 and 15" Dan Wesson barrels and Thompson Cente's 10 and 14" barrels, we are not aware of any new guns or accessory barrels that will meet the IHMSA ruling for the 1977 International Championships.
