Also the glue holding the silicone prism is still not holding well enough so the next glue to try is a special silicone super glue that is supposed to hold silicone to metal etc. But all in all the hit indicators worked very well and everybody was impressed by the flashing red strobe LEDs! Its always fun to try something new.
