49th Nationals will be held at Riley Conservation Club in Terre Haute, IN on July 18-24, 2025.

- As usual I can take emails, phone calls, text but prefer emails. I make every effort to respond to an email the day I receive it and usually will have a confirmation of your times back to you by 3 days at the latest.
- If you do not get a response to your registration, call me or text me. A couple years ago I had a few go to junk and almost missed them.
- The earlier you register the better your chances of getting exactly the times that you requested.

Please note following special circumstances;

1. BB Rams will be equipped with lighted hit indicators as they were in 2023.
2. All three Practical Hunter categories will be offered. 500 meter is not available at this match.
3. Big bore will be available from 9:00am to 1:45pm then that line switches to half scale which will be offered 2:00pm to 5:00. Trees are being cut this month to alleviate some of the shadow.
4. Thursday is a half day from 9:00am to 1:00pm. No half scale offered on Thursday. Shoot-offs to follow last regular entry if needed. Awards following final tabulation of scores.
5. Air will be shot on the patio on Sunday from approx. 2:00 till ? and Tuesday from approx. 2:00 till ?
6. I haven't verified with Rich yet but I am assuming mandatory shoot-offs for perfect scores immediately after the perfect score is fired.
7. Practice is available on Friday until the range is closed at end of day for beginning of Championship start on Saturday.
8. Wednesday currently scheduled for Delegates business meeting and banquet.
9. Some carpets are available but it never hurts to bring your own.

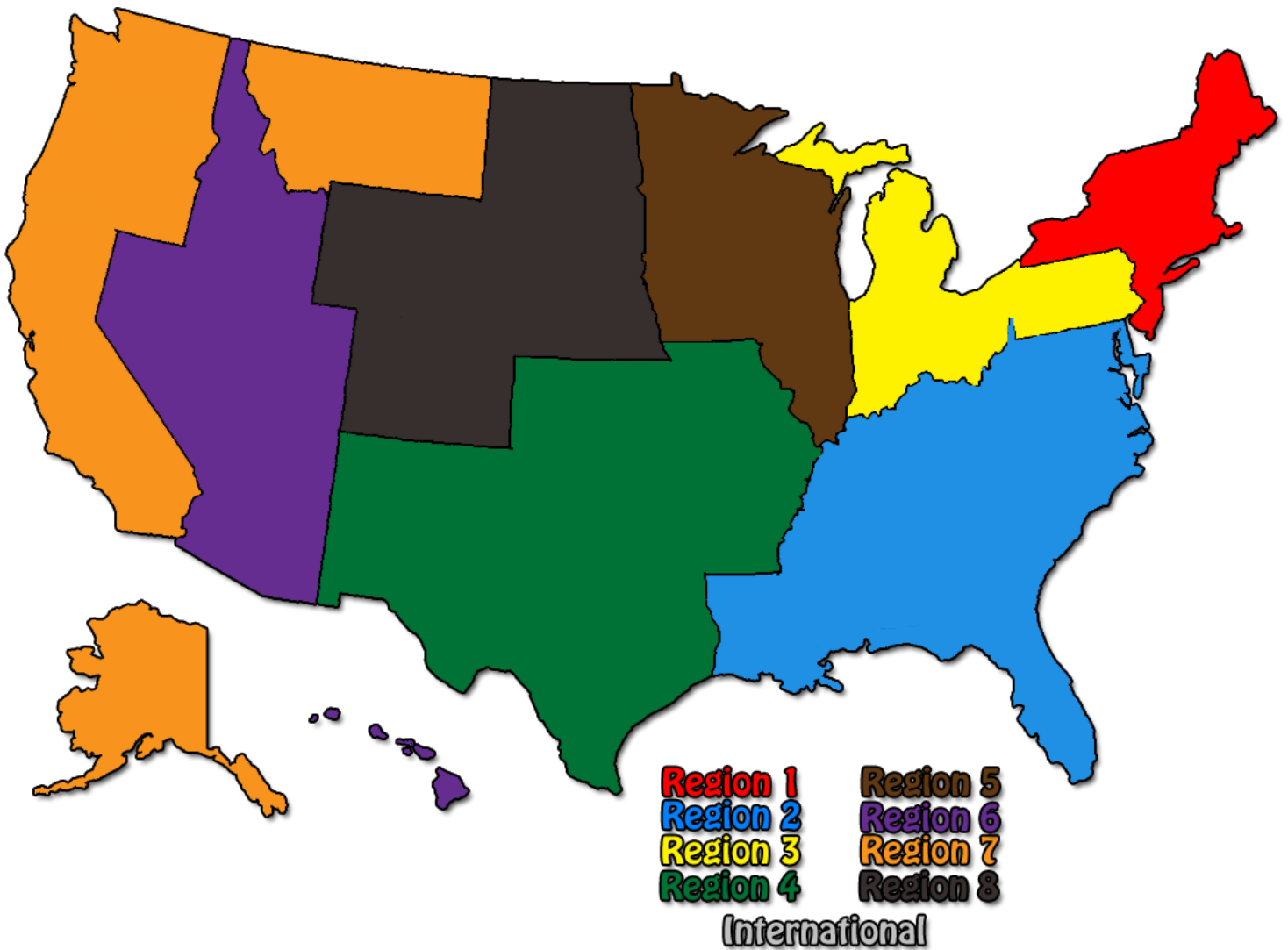

IHMSA simply forwards the letter to our tax people, they send a letter to the IRS that this was resolved several years ago, and the problem goes away for another year. How are we doing financially? The short answer is....pretty darn good!! In

2024, IHMSA gained \$8595.60 amongst our bank accounts. Easily enough to allow us to host the annual 2025 World Championships with a little money to spare. 2024 Final standings

This was the first entry for 2024.

Jack Lambert from WV. shot a 64 in the 60 club at his last match. It was an interesting 60 club on several fronts. Jack is using one of the new SSK-50 stainless Contender clones and man are they sweet. CNC tolerances and all the parts are interchangeable with the original Contender. All the blue and stainless barrels from both G1 and G2 Contenders will fit the SSK-50. I do not know if Armor Alloy barrels will fit.

The other interesting item about Jack's record is the calibers he is using. The PAS score was a 33 and was shot with a 25-20 barrel made by Bull berry. I personally have fallen in love with the 25-20 and am shooting it myself. I even went so far as to buy a Marlin lever gun in 25-20. Several people have extolled the virtues of the ancient 25-20 for the Field Pistol game. Mr. Steve Ware championed it for years and he was kind enough to send me some of his brass recently.

Jack's Prod score was a 31 and is even a tad more interesting. Jack had a .270 Ren barrel made by MGM back in the day when he was shooting NRA Hunter Pistol. 12" barrels were legal for NRA at the time so that is how Jack ordered his barrel. That was a few years ago so to make it legal for IHMSA rules of 10 3/4", he sent it back to MGM to be cut and crowned. If you are not familiar with the .270 Ren, it is a .22 hornet blown out straight walled. Think of a .32 HR except in .270 caliber. It too is an excellent cartridge for IHMSA Field Pistol and if you shoot on ranges with sticky rams you might want to consider the 25-20 or the .270 Ren. Both start with heavier bullets than the Hornet and you can move the bullet a lot slower. Recoil on both is negligible.

The Richards all went to the big Pringle match and shot some terrific scores.

Jared shot a 38 in Prod. and a 36 in PAS for a 74 aggregate

A. J. shot a 32 in Prod. and a 33 in PAS. for a 65 aggregate

This puts Jared in first place in Prod and in the aggregate and tied for first in PAS.

IHMSA has had some father/son combos who were excellent shooters but I cannot remember a trio from the same family that were such great shooters. Particularly in the standing categories. Here is a tip; they shoot a lot of air pistol.

John and I chat occasionally and he told me they have made up a set of 1/20 scale air targets. If you are familiar with the sizes of our animals; small bore is 3/8 scale, the little small bore is 1/5 scale, normal air targets are 1/10.

A 1/20 air target chicken would not be much bigger than a pellet! Might be one of the reasons they all shoot so well! Congratulations to all the Richards! Those are impressive scores!

quite some time. We had a total of 4 perfect 40s shot in Small Bore and Practical Hunter. Congratulations to Wayne Young and Dale Adams. Along with our shooters, we had a number of guests and club members watching the competition and seeing what silhouette shooting is all about.

Shelby Bentley heard about our match at the club meeting and came out to try his rifle on the rim fire targets using his Ruger 77 in 17 HMR. He knocked over 22 his first time out. We did discover some target damage on a couple of chickens hit in the leg, so we won't allow the 17 HMR out of rifle going forward. Hope Shelby will be back again with other guns. Caleb Dean, our range master, brought his new Rossi breaking it in for CLRPC and CLR shoots. At the rate he's going, he may be a real threat for our September CLR shoot.

Our side match this month was "Field Pistol with a 1911" which carried over from last month since the February match had such a wind storm. The "rules" were any 1911 in any chambering with barrel no longer than 6 inches using iron sights or a red dot. Sight adjustments were allowed like in Field Pistol though most had no adjustment options. No one shot a red dot or any barrel length longer than 5 inches. Guess we are a bunch of traditionalists.

Results of the "1911" match are below. Since those that have a classification in Field Pistol (FP) production (P) likely did not earn that classification with a 1911 and since several club members joined for this club match, I listed the competitors from high to low score rather than by classification. None of us shot any higher than a FP P class B score, so those without a classification were classified as B.

Let me know your feedback of whether we should try the 1911 match again next year. I'm also looking for suggestions for other side matches to go along with our August Big Bore

Revolver Standing and September Cowboy
Lever Rifle matches. It was suggested to have a
side match every month, so I need your
suggestions.

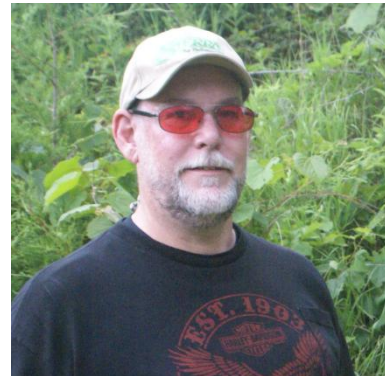
